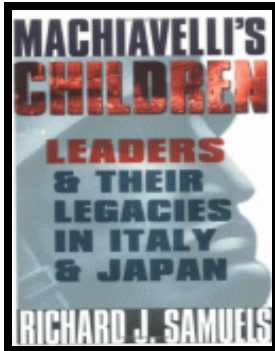


A discourse by three drunkards on government by Nakae Chomin. New York: Weatherhill, 1984.
