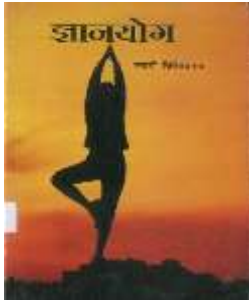

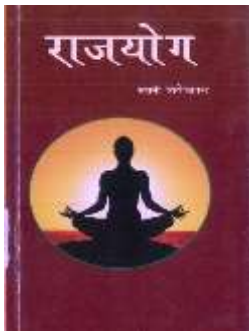


Gyanyog by Swami Vivekanand. New Delhi: Shivank Prakashan, 2017.
