Indiastat.com is an authentic storehouse of socio-economic statistical data about India and its sectors, regions & states.

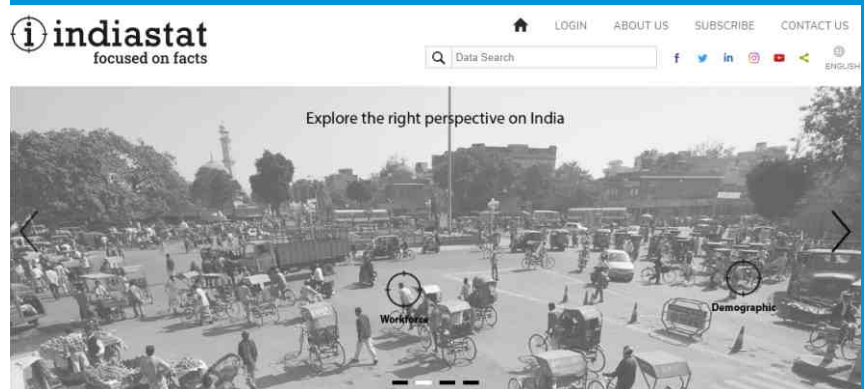
